

Annual Report 2022-2023



Sanjoe Sadan Special School is an institution working under St. Joseph Social Centre in Thuravoor Panchayat, Alappuzha District in Kerala. The school came into operation on 6th January, 1992. It started with 12 students, and grew to 129 students and 23 Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff.

Training

2022 June 1 after midsummer holydays started the current academic year started after summer holydays, on June 1, 2022. There are students from age 4 to 43, being given training in 9 classes divided on the basis of intelligence and age. They develop their ability to interest; have coordinated movements, and speech. The classes start at 9.30 am till 3.30 pm. Students are trained from toilet training to vocational training. Yoga, band, sports and games, art and craft, dance, music, computer classes all help to develop their physical and mental capabilities. After training here, the students go to earn their livelihood working in different fields. The training is based on SCERT syllabus.

Vocational training is imparted to help students find their work and livelihood. They learn things like making soap powder, candle, lotion, newspaper covers, cotton waste making, rabbit farming, and horticulture. They are helped to do these in school and at home.

Each child needs different levels and kinds of skills and training. Physiotherapy for physically handicapped, and speech therapy for those with speech problems, and multisensory therapy for those with autism are provided. Also, there is psychological help and psychiatrist's help available for their comprehensive development.

Inclusys Computer Training course

Inclusys Computer Training Program was started in the school to identify the talents of children and develop them in the field of IT. It includes 13 children and trained teachers. After 6 months of training, the school is able to earn a fixed income for the children who have completed the training through data entry.
